Lifeline to Refugees

Christian World Service has launched Operation Refugee 2018, a 5 day challenge to live on the same food as in a refugee emergency food parcel. This year's challenge runs from June 16th - 20th. Once a participant raises \$87, enough to pay for a good quality food parcel in Jordan for a family of six - CWS will send a Food Box containing lentils, chickpeas, kidney beans, fish (or vegan or vegetarian options), flour, vegetable oil and salt. Participants supply their own rice and earn fresh vegetables and other ingredients by meeting fundraising goals. CWS is fundraising for the Department of Service to Palestinian Refugees in Jordan and Lebanon. The parish is encouraged to support Syrian refugees on Refugee Sunday, 1st July. More information is
