Dunedin Hospital Chapel, 1.00-2.00pm, Thursday 23rd August. The guest speaker will be our Bishop Steven. He was ordained Priest in 2000 in the Diocese of York. In his first four years as a priest he served as a curate in a three-church rural cluster, while remaining a full-time specialist at Friarage Hospital, Northallerton in Yorkshire. For ten years Bishop Steven then served as the Vicar of a Church in the city of York and worked two days a week as an anaesthetist in Northallerton. Before returning to Dunedin, Bishop Steven served as Vicar of St Joseph the Worker, Northolt, in the Diocese of London, where he was also a Bishops' Advisor for Ministry, a new
